

ABOUT THE SHOW

Vadrózsa ('Wild Rose') will take part in a five-city tour of the East Coast of the United States in the fall of 2024. The highlight of the performance series is the commemoration organized jointly with the Hungarian Embassy in Washington, which pays tribute to the memory of the revolution and freedom struggle of October 23, 1956. The revolution is one of the most significant events in Hungarian history, which began with a peaceful demonstration by Budapest University students and within a few days escalated into an armed conflict against the Soviet occupation. Although the uprising was crushed, its international impact played an important role in the process leading to the eventual fall of the Soviet Union.
